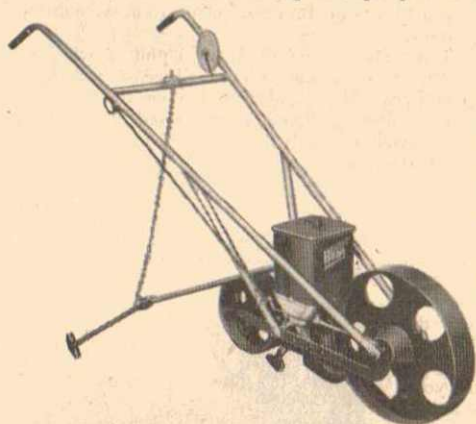
**SEED BOX OR HOPPER CAPACITY.**—Four quarts.

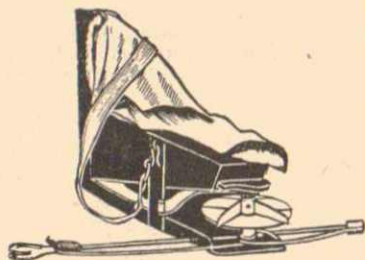
## THE "BEAN" GANG SEEDER UNIT (T)

## THE "AERO" HAND SEED SOWER



A simple contrivance with lifetime wear. For grain and small seed sowing. Instantly regulated.

The bow moves through two spring cushioned holes in cradle abutting bobbin, the thong passing direct to bobbin.

The fiddle movement of bow revolves distributor, and in conjunction with the steady step of user gives an ideal seed



distribution of from 16 ft. to 24 ft. cast, according to the user's desires and variety of seed used; one step per bow-stroke. Body of wood surmounted by seed bag of ample proportions, fitting on user's left side, supported by shoulder strap.
